"The funeral of the late **Mr Arthur Catterall**, the famous violinist (who died on Sunday 28th November 1943) took place at Southern Cemetery, Manchester, on Saturday. Two of Mr Catterall's string quartet colleagues Mr F. Park and **Mr J. Bridge** attended. Another old friend at the graveside was Mr R. J. Forbes, principal of the Royal Manchester College of Music." *Lancashire Evening Post, Monday 6th December 1943*

**John Sedgwick Bridge** died on the 2nd July 1945 and this appreciation, written by Robert J. Forbes, principal of the Royal Manchester College of Music, appeared in the Manchester Evening News on Tuesday 3rd July 1945. "Death of **Mr. John Bridge** removes one of the most prominent and popular figures in Manchester music circles for more than fifty years. Joining the Halle Orchestra in 1893, when Sir Charles was still its conductor, **Mr Bridge** was for a considerable period principal second violinist and at one time leader of the orchestra. He was also for many years a teacher on the staff of the Royal Manchester College of Music. As a violinist his extraordinary natural facility invoked the admiration of his staunch and loyal friend Fritz Kreisler, and the envy not only of his orchestral colleagues but of many violinists who achieved much greater fame than fell to his lot. That with his superb technical equipment he never became a distinguished soloist was due to lack of ambition, disdain of popular appreciation, and a certain coldness in his playing. Music was never an all-absorbing passion with him and violin playing was rather incidental to his day's activities than their focal point; he was a low handicap golfer, a first- class billiards player, and an expert at all card games. By nature he was a Bohemian fond of conviviality, cheerful in impecuniosity and recklessly generous when in funds, but withal a shrewd judge of people and events. His genial and likeable personality will be greatly missed by a host of friends both in the musical profession and out of it."

**Death of Mr Johan Hock.** "Birmingham has lost one of its best-known musicians in the death of Mr Johan C. Hock, which occurred last night at Selly Oak Hospital. Mr Hock, who was founder and conductor of the Birmingham Philharmonic Orchestra Society, was born at Amsterdam 70 years ago, and studied at the Amsterdam Conservatoire under Mengelberg, conductor of the Concertgebouw Orchestra, in which he played as 'cellist for four years before he came to Birmingham 1898. He was a founder member of the Catterall Quartet (1911) and until recently was teacher of the 'cello and a chamber music coach in Birmingham". *Birmingham Daily Gazette, Saturday 11th May 1946*  
"Mr Johan C. Hock is a native of Holland, born at Amsterdam, where he studied with Professor Ivan Mossel and Willem Kes at the Conservatoire, and was a member for five years of the celebrated Concertgebouw Orchestra under Willem Mengelberg. He then came to settle in Birmingham, where he still resides. He is principal 'cello for Sir Thomas Beecham's newly-formed permanent orchestra, and teacher a great deal there. Nearly all the professional players are pupils of his there. He has toured extensively as soloist on the Continent, and is very well known as such in the Midlands and the North. Mr Hock also plays the viol da gamba". *The Musical Standard, 30th March 1918*

**Frank S. Park** of 25 Lambton Road, Chorlton-cum-Hardy, Manchester 21 died on the 25th January 1956. He studied under Dr Brodsky at the Royal Manchester College of Music. As well as being the Halle's principal viola, he was also an excellent violinist. "Mr Park (who is principal viola in the Halle and BBC Northern Orchestras) joined the Halle Orchestra at the age of 18, and not long afterwards Dr Richter invited him to go with him to Covent Garden for three seasons". *Hartlepool Daily Mail, 29th May 1936*
